HAPPY EASTER to you all – Christ is Risen, Hallelujah!

As I write this just before the week the worldwide church designates "Holy Week", I have been discussing with Peter using the SJI YouTube playlist The Week That Changed the World - YouTube in the services over the Easter period, the first being "Day 1 – Palm Sunday" shown in church on Sunday 24 March, "Day 6 – Good Friday" to be shown during our Good Friday Reflective service. I recommend viewing all the videos in that playlist and draw your friends attention to them as well.

We recall the stories in the Gospels of the events of the week that did indeed change the world beginning with the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on what we now call Palm Sunday, but not on a white horse with a great procession but riding on a colt, the foal of a donkey, he came as the Prince of Peace in humility, as the Servant King. The striking thing is that the crowds who greeted him with such joy with palm branches shouting "Hosanna! – Blessed is the King of Israel" may well have included the same people who a week later would be calling out in the mockery of a trial "Take him away! Take him away! Crucify him!". The fickleness of human nature is exposed.

Jesus is indeed the true king who brings peace to a troubled world and to you and me whatever state or situation we find ourselves in today. We look forward to that great day when Jesus the Prince of Peace returns in glory and majesty as King of Kings and Lord of Lords and takes those who have believed and trusted in his finished work of salvation to be with Him forever! A day when there will be no more pain and suffering or wars.

#### **Nat West Mobile Banking**

The fortnightly visits of Nat West's mobile banking unit to our car park are due to take place on Wednesday 3rd and 17th of April, between 1:30 and 2:30 pm. We have been assured by Nat West that their van is now back on the road following an accident, so these visits should take place.

#### **Creche/Tiddlers**

During the morning service on Sundays, with the exception of Family Church weeks (first Sunday of the month) the various children's groups function. For school-aged children the groups run primarily to provide age-appropriate Bible teaching. The creche and Tiddlers group runs primarily to ensure that the parents of little ones are able to access the communion and teaching slots in the main hall without worrying about their children.

When the service runs to the usual format, all of the children will be in the main hall for the first 10 minutes or so and will then leave for their groups. At this point the preschool children will join the Treasure Seekers upstairs for some singing and will then go to their own room downstairs to play. This may include a Bible story and activity but we are flexible and led by the mood and interest of the children.

Currently we only have 3 volunteers to take this group and on some weeks may not be able to provide cover or may need additional assistance.

If you would like to join the team, we would love to have you. The position requires a DBS check, the ability to interact well with young children and possibly the ability to sit on the floor (!!). Please speak to Corinne for more information.

On Family Church weeks there are no groups organised for the children as the service is designed to be more interactive and all inclusive. If your child is fractious and uncomfortable, please feel free to take them out to the creche room, next to the main hall. If your child is fidgety but happy, please don't feel that you need to remove them from the service. We love to have them trotting around, shaking shakers and doing what children do.

#### **New Surface Cleaner**

To consistently comply with food hygiene requirements, we have purchased a 'fast-acting', British Standards compliant surface cleaner called Jantex which is the **only** product that should be used in the kitchen and servery areas and for table cleaning from now on. 
