

Easter Trail

Instructions

Welcome to the Staplehurst Free Church Easter trail.

The trail consists of 11 'egg' posters.
There are letters to spot and quiz questions to answer.
To complete the trail, you will need the following:



1. A smart phone with the "What3words" app installed. This will help you to navigate the trail and find the posters.
2. A copy of The Easter Story information sheet. You can use the QR code to access the story online while you walk or print a copy before you start or, take a ready-printed copy where you find the first poster.
3. A quiz sheet - again you can access it using the QR code, print your own or pick one up with the story.
4. A pen or pencil



The three words to start the trail are: **bleaker.likening.enclosing**

Put these into What3Words to navigate to the location. You can type the words, speak them or scan with your phone. At each location look for the egg poster as addresses from apps may be inaccurate.

The trail will be available for two weeks starting from 1.30pm on Saturday 4th April to 5pm on Saturday 18th April. If necessary, you may leave your car at the church. The trail should cover a distance of around 2 miles and take approximately 1 hour to complete.

We want you to enjoy this trail in a safe way.
Please remember to take care when **crossing roads.**

Some fun activities and crafts will be taking place at the church from 2.30pm to 5pm on Saturday 4th April. So, if you choose to do the trail on this day, come in and join us!
Refreshments and snacks will be available too!
